- 10.) Amended Resolution #2020-04 Award of Trench Drain Replacement Project. Dave Green informed the Commissioners that the trench drain project was rebid by all contractors in order for Metro Bus to exercise their tax exempt benefit. The bid was won and service will be performed by Restoration Construction Services (RCS). Commissioner Hunstiger moved and Commissioner Libert seconded a motion to approve Resolution #2020-04 Award of Trench Drain Replacement Project as amended. Motion carried.
- 11.) <u>Consideration of Cell Phone Policy.</u> Paula Mastey presented a policy to the Commissioners that will allow qualified employees the opportunity for an allowance toward their cell phone plan. The new policy would replace the current reimbursement plan that Metro Bus is currently operating under.

14.) <u>COVID-19 Update.</u> Ryan Daniel gave the Commissioners an update as to what Metro Bus is doing to keep the employees, as well as the public, safe during the COVID-19 pandemic. Mr. Daniel noted that Metro Bus resumed full service for the Fixed Route and Dial-a-Ride Services on July 12, 2020 and the Northstar Link Service is currently operating two A.M. trips as well as two P.M. trips to Big Lake which is consistent with the train schedule. Metro Bus has continued rear-door boarding and no collection of fares until the complete installation of the operator safety shields. Mr. Daniel informed the Commissioners that with the St. Cloud City Council's mandatory mask mandate, all Metro Bus employees will be required to wear a face covering on buses as well as in offices when in the presence of a customer or other outside vendors.
