Public Open Forum.

1) Open Discussion. There were no members of the public present.

New Business:

- 1) <u>Ridership Update</u>
 - a. Overall, ridership was up in the month of February as compared to previous months.
 - i. The largest increase was route 31, at 12%.
 - ii. Next, was route 8, at 10%.
 - iii. Routes 10 & 12 were down around 2%.
 - b. Connex had an increase in ridership of 10%.
 - c. Northstar Link had a decrease of 8%.
 - i. There was a decrease in number of weekdays of service from January to February, Northstar only runs on weekdays.
 - d. Dial a ride remains stable, there was a slight increase of about 200 more trips provided.
- 2) <u>Spring Outlook:</u>
 - a. We are in the freeze-melt and refreeze season.
 - i. Be careful and look out for icy conditions
 - ii. Metro Bus staff is vigilant to clear and prepare surfaces at Metro Bus facilities and shelters for icy conditions as they are able
 - 1. Report locations of concern to your driver or customer service.

4) <u>Open Discussion</u>:

- a. Mask Mandate extended through April 18th.
- b. Route 6&7 will have changes to the route, not on the run time.
 - i. The loop will be served on the outbound leg of each route.
 - ii. This expansion will include additional service to one bus stop on Benton Dr. that is currently served by Route 22.
 - iii. There will be four bus stops added for this extension, two on Lincoln Ave. and two on Franklin Ave.
 - iv. Three of the new stops have shelters.
 - 1. Dubow Textile
 - 2. Near Gopher Bargain Center on Lincoln Ave.
 - 3. Near Crescent St. on Franklin Ave.
 - v. The routes will also stop at the Metro Bus Operations Center.
 - vi. The rest of Routes 6 and 7 will not be affected and the routes will remain 45-minute loops.
 - vii. One bus stop on East St. Germain St. will be removed to allow buses to make a left turn onto Lincoln Ave.
