HOW TO RIDE METRO BUS

- Plan your trip. Metro Bus has Routes serving St. Cloud, Sartell, Sauk Rapids and Waite Park. There are several ways to find your route:
 - Find travel times, routes and trip planning on our online **Trip Planner** tool as well as the Metro Bus Smart Ride App. Just type your starting point, destination and the time you wish to travel and our trip planners will give you route options.
 - Individual route schedules are available online, at locations around the community including the Mobility Training Center and Transit Center, as well as on all Fixed Route buses. View the System Map online or at the Transit Center to see an overview of the entire bus system.
- Arrive at your bus stop five minutes early to avoid missing the bus. If you are waiting in a shelter, step out to be more visible to the Operator.
- Show the Bus Operator your student ID or Metro Bus U-Go Free ID Card. If your traveling companions are over 17 years old, they must pay a fare. Several fare options are available depending on travel needs. More information about fares is available at ridemetrobus.com/fares.
- Pull the yellow cord about one block before your destination to allow the bus time to
- Follow the rules. The Metro Bus Code of Conduct is posted on all buses, at each facility and online: ridemetrobus.com/code-of-conduct.
