The meeting was held to discuss ridership, discuss the status of the Metro Bus Forward project, present results from the Jolley Trolley Food Drive, present website updates, as well as various other questions.

Welcome. Michael thanked everyone for coming and reviewed the purpose of the RAC.

Old Business:

- 2) Review of December Minutes: The meeting was held to discuss ridership, discuss the status of the Metro Bus Forward project, discuss the Jolley Trolley Food Drive, as well as various other questions.

New Business:

1. Ridership Update – December was a month when all routes varied in performance.
  - a. Overall ridership was up, with 50,500 trips provided on fixed routes.
    - i. Route 6 saw the largest increase with over 500 more rides provided over last month.
    - ii. Next was route 21 with a 13% increase, or 350 more trips provided.
    - iii. Routes 1, 2 and 3 saw slight decreases.
  - b. Dial a ride provided 13,216 rides
    1. Numbers are up over 1,000 from last year.
  - c. In the North Star Link's last month of service, it provided 1,032 rides.
2. Metro Bus Forward Updates
  - a. Schedules are being pieced together.
  - b. Stops are being finalized and mapped out for future placement.
  - c. Routes are being named/numbered.

3. Jolly Trolley Final Results
  - a. Collection totals this year were \$3,038 and 9,211 pounds of non-perishables.
  - b. Over the last 15 years, the Jolly Trolley has distributed well over forty-three tons of non-perishables and just shy of \$40,000.
